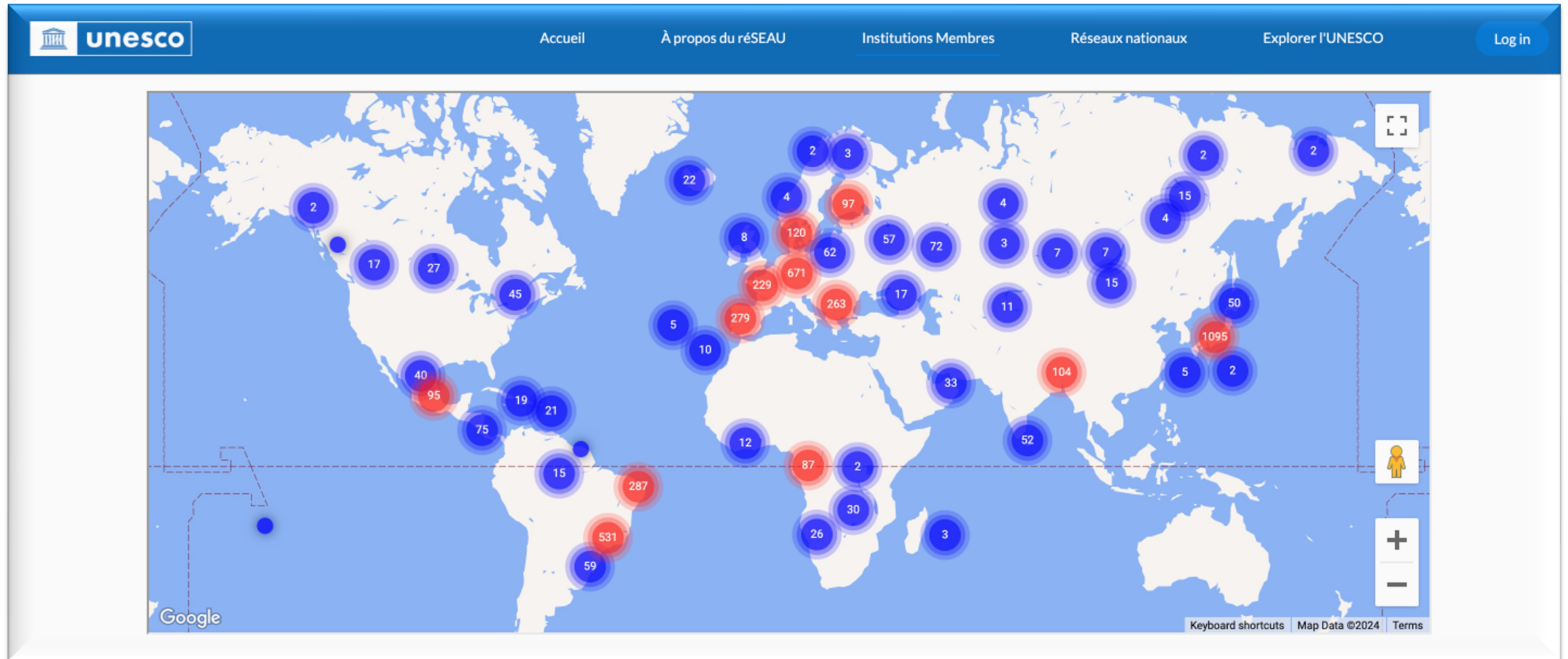

1. Inactive National Networks, no clean data

These are the National Networks for which we have currently no recent proof of activity and involvement. Inactive national networks are at risk of not migrating to the new platform and might eventually even step out of ASPnet.

TO DO:

National Coordinators are asked to check the contact information on [ASPnet's webpage](#) and to write an email to aspnet@unesco.org demonstrating recent activity of the National Network.



2. Active Networks, no clean data

These are the networks for which we have proof of recent activity and involvement, but which have not completed the data cleaning exercise.

TO DO:

National Coordinators are asked to write an email to aspnet@unesco.org with requesting for an online meeting to receive support.



3. Active Networks, updated Members data

These are the networks that have completed the data cleaning exercise, but for which we do not yet have the network's general information.

4. Active Networks, updated Network data

These are the active networks for which we have gathered all data.

TO DO:

The International Coordination Unit processed the data from the clean data lists, the national network data survey and merges these data with other data – if any – from our previous application tools (OTA and temporary SharePoint Solution). Then the data is pasted in templates for mass upload to the new environment. This is a laborious and time-consuming process as the old data is scattered in different places and needs to be modified to respect the data format and restrictions of upload templates.



5. Active Networks, migration Prepared

These are the networks for which the International Coordination Unit has prepared the data migration. As the preparation of the clean data for upload takes a lot of time and since the UNESCO is working with an external IT company to upload the data and to unlock the application tool, data is uploaded into cohorts of around 20 National Networks each time.

TO DO:

The International Coordination Unit uploads the data to the new directory and unlocks the new application tool.



6. Active Networks, migrated

These are the active networks that have been migrated to the new platform.

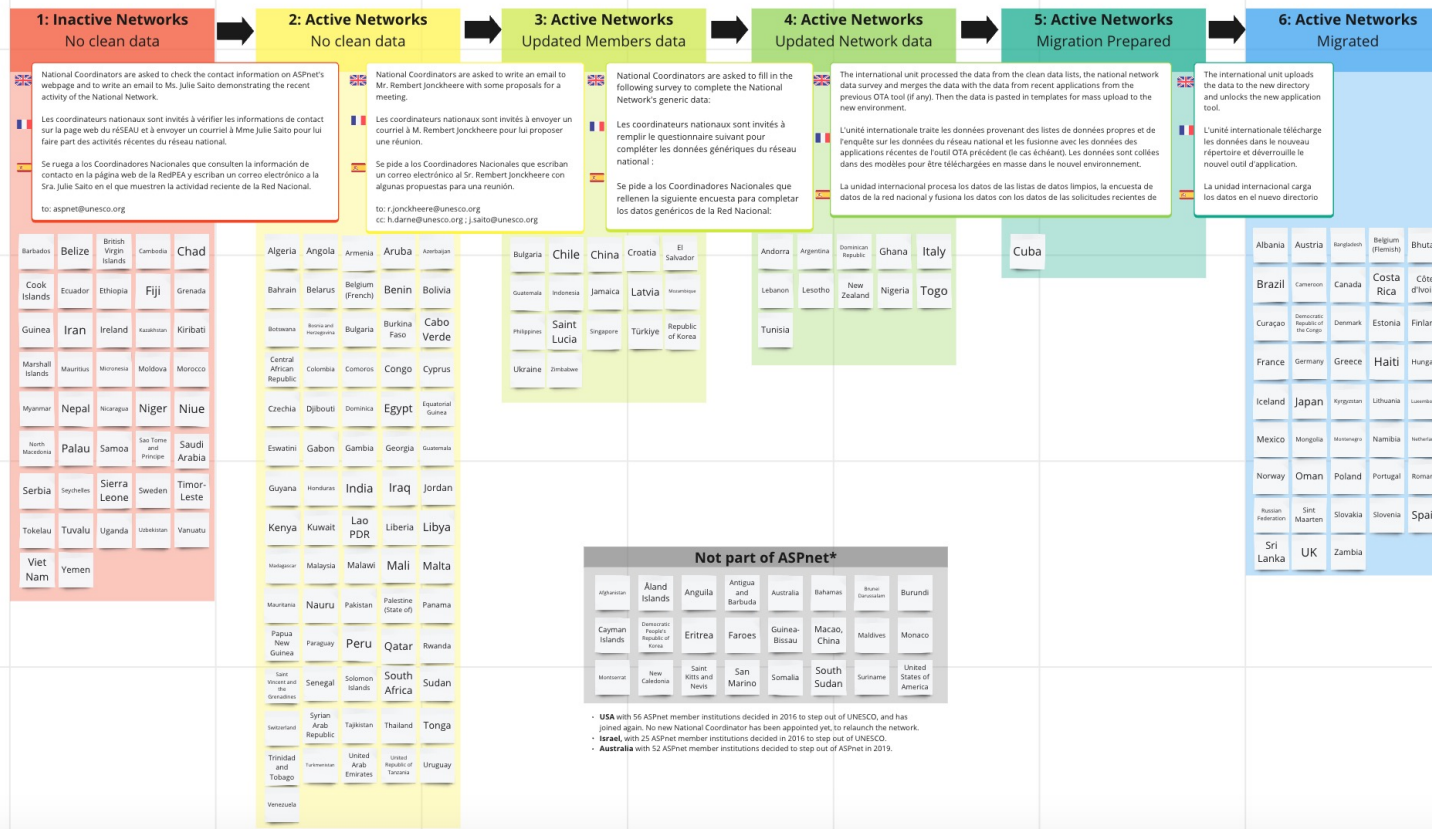
TO DO:

The International Coordination Unit invites the National Coordinators separately to the new platform and organizes a training session for each cohort.

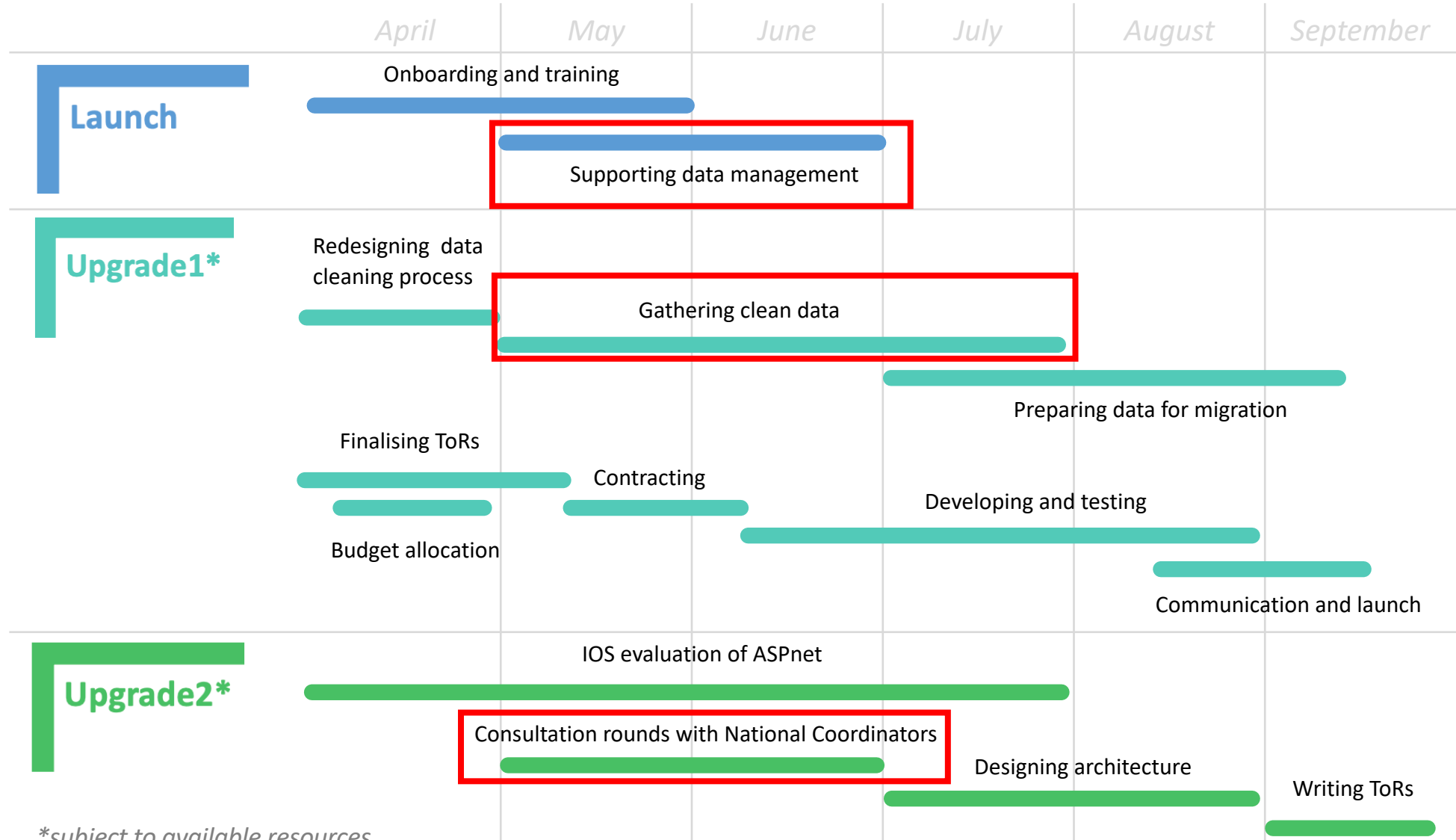

Criteria

- The banner should represent the identity of ASPnet
 - It can be a picture or a graphic illustration
 - Dimension: 1900x800 pixels
 - Not too crowded, and no faces on the right side.
 - Not too bright as the title of the platform is white.
 - No text visible

- Grand of rights should be retrievable.
 - = 1 GOR from the owner/creator of the image
 - + 1 GOR for each recognisable person (Children --> GOR of Parent)

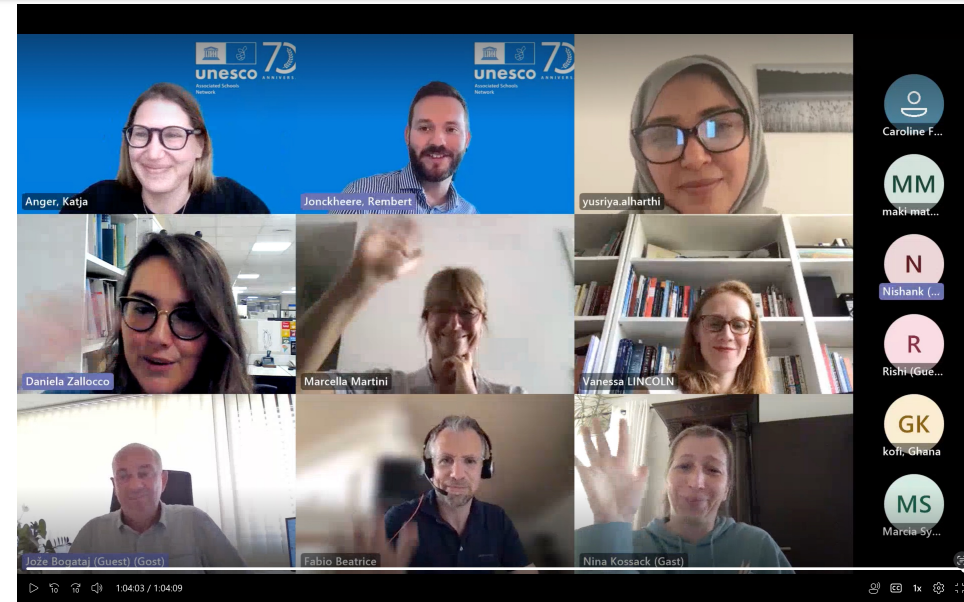
